

Emergency plan

In the event of an emergency or natural disaster, please take the actions below.

Evacuation

Any of these emergencies could trigger an evacuation of the site:

- Fire
- Earthquake
- Serious accident
- Structural collapse
- Tsunami
- Volcanic eruption
- Explosion
- Aviation incident
- Hazardous spill OR
- Trial evacuation

If you need to evacuate the site, you will hear a Siren alarm

When you hear this sound:

1. If safe to, **Shut down** all plant and equipment.
2. **Go** immediately, via the safest route, to the emergency assembly point.
3. **Stay** there, so everybody can be accounted for.
4. **Do not return** to the site until the emergency wardens have given clearance.
5. Dial **111** for: fire, ambulance, police, gas leaks and chemical spills.

When calling 111 they will want to know:

- Which service you need: Fire / Police / Ambulance
- Exact location
- Phone number
- What is happening
- Any injuries
